

- + International multi-stakeholder platform
- Making governments/parliaments more open, accountable, and responsive to citizens
- + Co-creation by civil society and government/parliaments

- Self-assessments / Independent Reporting
- Peer learning and exchange



Action Oriented

- + Governments and civil society co-create action plans
- + Secure concrete commitments
- + Whole of government approach


Flexible but Ambitious




OGP Participation and Co-Creation Standards

- + WHEN IMPLEMENTING, MONITORING AND REPORTING ON A NATIONAL ACTION PLAN




SPECTRUM OF PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

Principles for successful co-creation

- + Trust
- + Mutual conviction
- + Common objective
- Joint decisions
- Transversal leadership
- **Transparent communication**



Roles and responsibilities

Parliament

- Bears ultimate responsibility for quality of co-creation process and implementation
- Maintains OGP website and record-keeping
- Coordinates with government

Civil society

- Reaching out to other civil society actors and representing broader interests
- Provides feedback on process and implementation of commitments
- Co-implements commitments



INDEPENDENT REPORTING MECHANISM (IRM)

What is the IRM?

INDEPENDENT REPORTING MECHANISM TO HOLD OGP GOVERNMENTS/PARLIAMENTS TO ACCOUNT AND LEARN

- + Is formulation, implementation and monitoring of action plan collaborative and open?
- + Are action plans relevant, accountable and verifiable?
- + Are more ambitious actions getting done?
- + Research conducted by a local researcher.
- + Same researcher and timeline for government and parliament commitments

DESIGN REPORT

- + Process of action plan design
- + Commitments' contents

IMPLEMENTATION REPORT

- + At the conclusion of the National Action Plan cycle
- + Implementation over the two year cycle
- + Early results

- + Reports of implementing agencies
- + CSO reports
- + INTERVIEWS WITH CIVIL SERVANTS, CSOS, EXPERTS, BENEFICIARIES


